The data collected is used solely for statistical evaluations, to improve the website, direct marketing purposes and customer relationship management, to improve our knowledge of customers and potential customers and to offer you our products and services. However, the website operator reserves the right to subsequently check the server log files if there are concrete indications of illegal use.

Handling of personal data

For the above-mentioned purposes, your personal data may be disclosed to third parties and possibly processed by them, such as:

Employees, managers and/or representatives of the above-mentioned service providers or institutes and the specialist service providers commissioned by them must respect the confidentiality of this data and may only use this information in accordance with the company's instructions.

Personal data is any information that is used to identify you and which can be traced back to you, such as your name, e-mail address and telephone number.

Cookies

This website uses cookies. These are small text files that are stored on your terminal device. Your browser accesses these files. The use of cookies increases the user-friendliness and security of this website.
